- Applicants should have an interest in Architecture and the built environment and an understanding of, and a keen interest in, professional standards

Applicants should have a strong commitment to the objectives and values of APEAS. Experience of board/management committee level work is desirable but not essential.

These roles are not remunerated, but all reasonable costs associated with their effective discharge will be met. The Board normally meets 4 times a year.
